



# Duluth Centennial Homes Recognition Program

APPLICATION FORM    Deadline: April 19, 2010

Well-preserved exteriors of buildings that were originally built for residential use may be nominated (multi-family structures are eligible, but not structures that have a combined use with commercial or other types of uses). Other qualifying criteria: **1.** The building must be documented to be 100 years old or older; **2.** The house should reflect its original architectural character; **3.** Additions and alterations are acceptable as long as the original architectural character has not been compromised (houses that have been resided with vinyl or other types of siding will not automatically be disqualified). **4.** The house shall not exhibit signs of deferred maintenance that threatens the economic life of the structure and the house should be a model of how we wish to have our older homes cared for.

Recognition of qualifying homes will be determined by a committee of the Duluth Preservation Alliance and certificates presented at a ceremony in May. This is an honorary award only and does not provide financial assistance.
